

DID YOU KNOW ABOUT P.A.P?

What is P.A.P?

P.A.P means 'Pre-Authorised Payment' it's a way of making a direct regular contribution to the church each month from your bank account to ours.

Why is P.A.P better than giving cash, cheque or by credit card?

P.A.P is the only form of donation that does not cost the Church anything. If you give by cash or cheque, or weekly envelope we are charged a fee from the bank for the deposit so the total you donate doesn't reach us. If you give by credit card, the credit company takes a fee of 3% so once again, we don't get your full donation amount.

How else does P.A.P. make a difference?

If you sign up to donate by P.A.P. it means the church has a predictable and regular cash flow throughout the year. It helps us to budget in advance and to meet regular expenses. It saves us time and money in counting and banking and means that your givings become a priority in your monthly budget without having to remember cheque or cash or envelope.

How do I sign up for P.A.P?

Just complete the form in the centre of this leaflet and pass it to the parish office together with a void cheque and we'll do the rest!

Anything else I should know?

Yes- P.A.P. is flexible and can be stopped or changed at any time (the Diocese needs one month's notice for change of amount) and you can still give special or one-off donations by envelope if you so choose!
